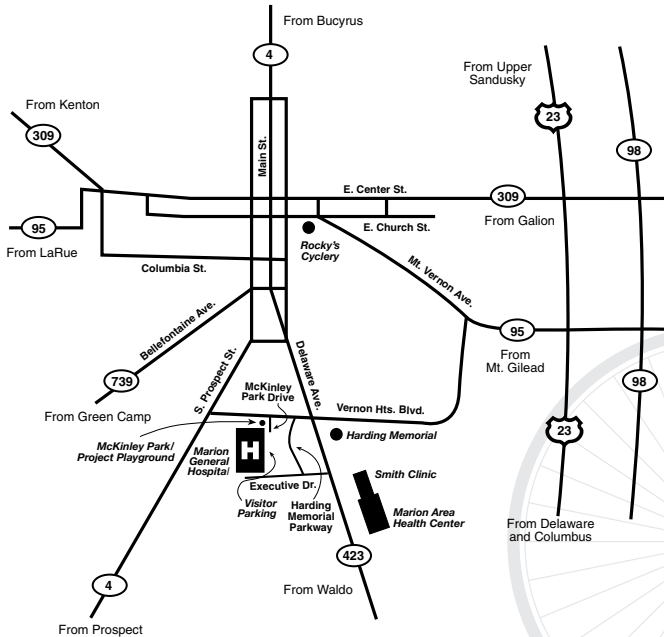


# MARION GENERAL HOSPITAL POPCORN 100 BIKE TOUR 2010

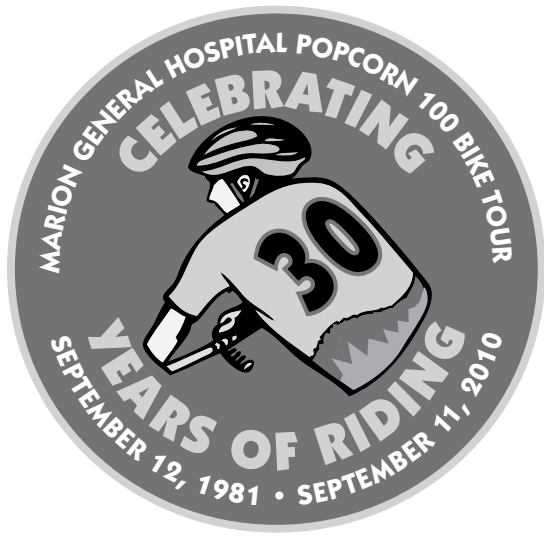
### T-Shirt Information

T-Shirts are available for those who pre-register by Friday, August 6, 2010.

**FEES INCLUDE** – Registration fees include snack stops, a route map, road markings, safety coverage, a Popcorn 100 embroidered patch and special treat after the ride.

**ROUTES** – There are two routes to choose from: a 25-mile and a 62-mile (100 km). Each route leaves from, and returns to, McKinley Park, adjacent to Marion General Hospital. The routes are relatively flat and are contained to Marion County.

**SAFETY COVERAGE** – Sponsored by the hospital, the Popcorn 100 has always been a safety conscious ride. HAM and CB operators form a safety network on the routes. The Marion County Medical Reserve Corp, staffed with emergency personnel, will be circulating for first-aid assistance and SAG wagons to pick up stranded cyclists.

**T-SHIRTS** – Those who pre-register by Friday, August 6, can order a short sleeved T-Shirt in deep yellow – tie dyed with a rainbow bottom wave with a white logo. \$12 - SM-XL, \$14 - 2X, \$15 - 3X. *See the order form on the registration panel.*



**MARION POPCORN FESTIVAL** – After an enjoyable day of cycling, head downtown to the Marion Popcorn Festival, the state's second-largest festival, and show off your new T-Shirt.

Registration forms will be accepted up to and on ride day. However, participation will be limited to 500 cyclists. **DATE, TIME AND LOCATION** – The Popcorn 100 will be held Saturday, September 11, 2010. The 62 and 25 mile rides get underway at 8 a.m. from McKinley Park adjacent to Marion General Hospital.

**PRE-REGISTRATION** – Pre-registration is strongly urged to guarantee participation in the Popcorn 100 because there is a 500-rider limit. **Pre-registration is a must for those who want T-Shirts.** The pre-registration deadline is Friday, August 6, 2010.

**SIGN-IN/SAME-DAY REGISTRATION** – Participants can sign in at McKinley Park shelterhouse adjacent to Marion General from 7-9 a.m. on ride day, but riders who depart before the designated start times will not receive safety coverage. Same-day registration will be available during sign-in hours until the 500-rider limit is met. Riders should arrive at least 30 minutes prior to designed departure time.

- Families – first member \$12, rest \$8 each

**LATE FEES** – after Friday, August 6

- Individuals \$14
- Families – first member \$14, rest \$10 each
