Directions

The Tin Duck is located on McMahon Blvd. off State Route 95, approximately 1/2 mile west of State Route 23. The group will meet at The Tin Duck at 5:00 p.m. and leave at 5:30 p.m. to head downtown.

If you arrive later . . . please use the following directions as many streets will be closed for the Orville Redenbacher Parade, as well as for the Marion Popcorn Festival.

From the East on Route 95 (Mt. Gilead area) Follow Rt. 95 into Marion. At the 10th stoplight, turn left onto Vernon Heights Blvd. Continue on Vernon Heights Blvd, crossing Delaware Ave. (there is a light and the Harding Memorial will be on your left). After you cross Delaware Ave., the road becomes McKinley Park Blvd. then Edgewood Drive. When you reach the light, turn right onto South Prospect St. At the 1st light, veer left onto Pearl St. (Duluth Ave. is a sharp left turn, Pearl St. is just beyond and angles off to the left). Take Pearl St. to West Church St. (it's the 3rd intersection). Turn right onto West Church, and then another right onto South Prospect St. The Fire Station will be on your left as you make this turn. Turn left into the alley just past the Fire Station and park where directed.

From the East on Route 309 (Galion/Mansfield area) When you reach U.S. 23, turn left onto the highway, go south 1 mile and exit right onto Rt. 95 and follow the above directions.

From the South on Routes 23 and 423 (Columbus/Delaware) Exit U.S. 23 onto Rt. 423 in Waldo and follow it north into Marion. At the 5th stoplight (the Harding Memorial will be on your right, Veterans Park on your left), turn left onto McKinley Park Blvd. When you reach the light, turn right onto South Prospect St. At 1st light, veer left onto Pearl Street (Duluth Ave. is a sharp left turn, here, Pearl St. is just beyond and angles off to the left). Take Pearl St. to West Church St. (it's the 3rd intersection). Turn right onto West Church, and then another right onto South Prospect St. The Fire Station will be on your left as you make this turn. Turn left into the alley just past the Fire Station and park where directed.

From the South on Route 4 (Marysville)

Follow Rt. 4 north into Marion until you reach the Duluth/Superior/Pearl Street stoplight (the 3rd stoplight). At the light, veer left onto Pearl St. (Duluth Ave. is a sharp left turn, here, Pearl St. is just beyond and angles off to the left). Take Pearl St. to West Church St. (it's the 3rd intersection). Turn right onto West Church, and then another right onto South Prospect St. The Fire Station will be on your left as you make this turn. Turn left into the alley just past the Fire Station and park where directed.

From the West on Route 309 (Kenton/Lima) Stay on Rt. 309 as you come into Marion. Route 309 becomes West Church St. As you reach the downtown area, turn right onto South Prospect St. The Fire Station will be on your left as you make this turn. Turn left into the alley just past the Fire Station and park where directed.

From the North on Routes 4 and 423 (Bucyrus/Upper Sandusky) Come into Marion on Rts. 4/423 which becomes North Main St. At Fairground St. (Elliot's is on your right), turn right and follow Fairground St. to Rt. 309. Turn left on St. Rt. 309 and follow the directions above from the west.

From the North on Route 23 (Findlay/Toledo) Take St. Rt. 23 south to the Rt. 4 exit. Turn right and follow the above directions for Rt. 4.
