PARADE INFORMATION FOR 2022 INCLUDES NEW INFO - PLEASE READ

• New Shorter Parade Route

 Parade route lines up on Forest Lawn Dr & starts on E. Center St. & Uhler Rd., heading West (toward downtown) on Center St, left on State St, left on Church St (in front of the Wyandot Popcorn Museum), disband at fork of Church St, Mount Vernon Ave, S Vine St.

• New Policy for Business Vehicles

 Sponsored vehicles (vehicles bearing logos of businesses for advertisement) are not required to decorate in the festival theme. They will be in the Sponsors Block at the end of the parade.

• New Policy on Youth Groups (ex: sport teams, dance studios, etc....)

- Youth groups will be walking in organized "Power Blocks"
- One vehicle will be allowed to follow behind the walkers for carrying water and health concerns. This vehicle can have the name of the group or organization displayed.

• New Policy on Floats

- Those wanting to enter a float in the parade must APPLY to be considered.
- Float applications must be received no later than August 5th
- All applicants will be notified no later than August 12th
- The Parade may contact applicants between submission and notification to ask additional questions about your entry.
- o If your submission is not selected, your entry fee will be refunded.

Antique Cars

 Any classic/antique car club may enter up to ten (10) vehicles under one entry fee with no limit on the number of passengers per vehicle. For each vehicle over 10 there will be an additional \$20.00/per vehicle fee.

Horses/Animals

All horses/animals will be considered one unit up to five (5) participants. There
will be an additional \$20.00/per animal fee for all horses/animals over the five (5)
allotted. Participants are solely responsible for animal waste cleanup during the
parade.

Political

- Any politically affiliated club or organization may enter one (1) float at the standard entry fee.
- Politicians currently holding office may ride in individual vehicles by submitting completed application along with standard entry fee.
